### **Tips** for writing

Let "body language" speak!

### How to express disappointment失望 / dismay惊愕:

- 皱眉 "Where could he go?" I murmured(低声抱怨) with a fierce frown.
- 失望地看 I shot/threw/cast <u>a frustrated look</u> at him.
- 摇头 I just shook my head in hopelessness.
- 哭 Tears of grievance (委屈) /ˈgriːvəns/ came into my eyes with the figure of my brother out of sight.
- 颤抖 Staring at the familiar figure out of sight, I was trembling with rage(愤怒) and chill(寒冷).

#### Show more than tell!

- <u>Consumed/ Overwhelmed</u>(吞噬)by a strong sense of nervousness and anxiety, Harry didn't know what to do, his heart <u>beating/pounding</u> wildly.(跳动)
- A flush of frustration <u>surging</u> (涌动) from the bottom of my heart, I froze with terror, trembling in icy water and hard to breathe.
- The thought of being abandoned/deserted by Harry <u>occupying</u> (占据) my mind, dismay and despair <u>accumulated</u> (积淀) in my heart.
- The icy water <u>pierced</u> (刺穿) my skin with needle-like chill as I was soaked(湿透) to the skin and <u>trembling/shivering</u> (颤抖).
- Desperate and exhausted, I was on the verge of <u>collapse</u> (崩溃). "Harry. Don't leave me alone." I <u>exclaimed</u> (呼喊).
- As I looked at his back, I wondered, "Is he running for help, or is he running way and leaving me alone?"

### Let "action" speak!



### How did Harry save me by using an oak branch橡树枝?

- push vt. 推动
- grab vt. 抓住,攫取
- · drag vt. 拖, 拉, 拽, 扯
- flop vi. 扑通落下
- wriggle vi. 蠕动,蜿蜒而行

<u>Flopping</u> to his stomach, Harry <u>pushed</u> the branch before him and <u>wriggled</u> toward me. When a slender top branch was within reach, I <u>grabbed</u> it. Eventually, I was <u>dragged</u> from the icy water.

### Let "action" speak!

• Seeing Harry <u>storming</u>(沖) back to the pond with a long stick in his hand, I was <u>injected</u>(注入) with fresh blood. The next few minutes <u>saw/witnessed</u> his dragging me to the shore inch by inch.

- Finally <u>came</u> Harry with a long rope. "<u>Grab</u>(抓住) it." He <u>threw/cast/flung</u> one end of the rope to me. Desperate to escape from the chilly pond, I <u>grasped</u> (抓紧) the lifeline tightly and was eventually <u>dragged/pulled</u>(拖;拉) up to the shore.
- <u>Stretching</u> (伸出) out my arms, I <u>seized</u> (抓住)the oak branch with all my strength and <u>crawled</u> (爬)carefully out of the hole inch by inch. I <u>survived</u> (幸存) eventually.



### **Tips** for writing

A story is an accident, which begins with a problem and ends with a solution.

A good story often has a good theme.

A better story "shows more than tells".

A great story displays details properly.


#### Para. 2:
