



Writing a summary

Writing a summary

To write a good summary of a text, you should:

- circle the main points and key ideas in a text;
- express these ideas in your own words;
- not include your personal opinion;
- not include supporting details or background knowledge;

- the main idea of each paragraph:

- linking words;
- no original sentences;
- no details and personal opinions;
- no spelling and grammar mistakes.



Possible version
