Embroidery (刺绣)

Chinese embroidery, a folk art with a long tradition, plays an important role in the history of Chinese arts and crafts. The oldest embroidered product in China appeared in the Shang Dynasty. From the magnificent (华丽的) Dragon Robe worn by Emperors to the popular embroidery seen in today's fashions, it adds so much pleasure to our life and culture.

Embroidery is a brilliant pearl in Chinese art, which has four major traditional styles: *Su Xiu*, *Xiang Xiu*, *Yue Xiu* and *Shu Xiu*. The Chinese word for embroidery is *Xiu*, which also means beautiful and magnificent.



Peking Opera

Peking Opera is listed as one of the cultural treasures of China. It was born when the “Four Great Anhui Troupes” brought *Huiju* (徽剧) in 1790 to Beijing, for the eightieth birthday of Emperor Qianlong. It was originally staged for the court and was only made available to the public later. Today, Peking Opera performers use four main skills: song (唱), speech (念), dance-acting (做) and combat (打). The four main roles in Peking Opera is *Sheng* (生), *Dan* (旦), *Jing* (净) and *Chou* (丑). Today Peking Opera serves as a bridge through which the traditional Chinese culture is introduced to other parts of the world.



Dragon Dance

Dragon Dance originated in China during the Han Dynasty, and is a traditional dance form in Chinese culture. Dragon represents wisdom, power and wealth. It is most often seen in festival celebrations. It is believed that performing dragon dance scares away evil spirits and all the bad luck, and brings in good luck and wealth instead. This is why dragon dance is very popular during Chinese Lunar New Year as well as during other occasions such as weddings and other festivities.
